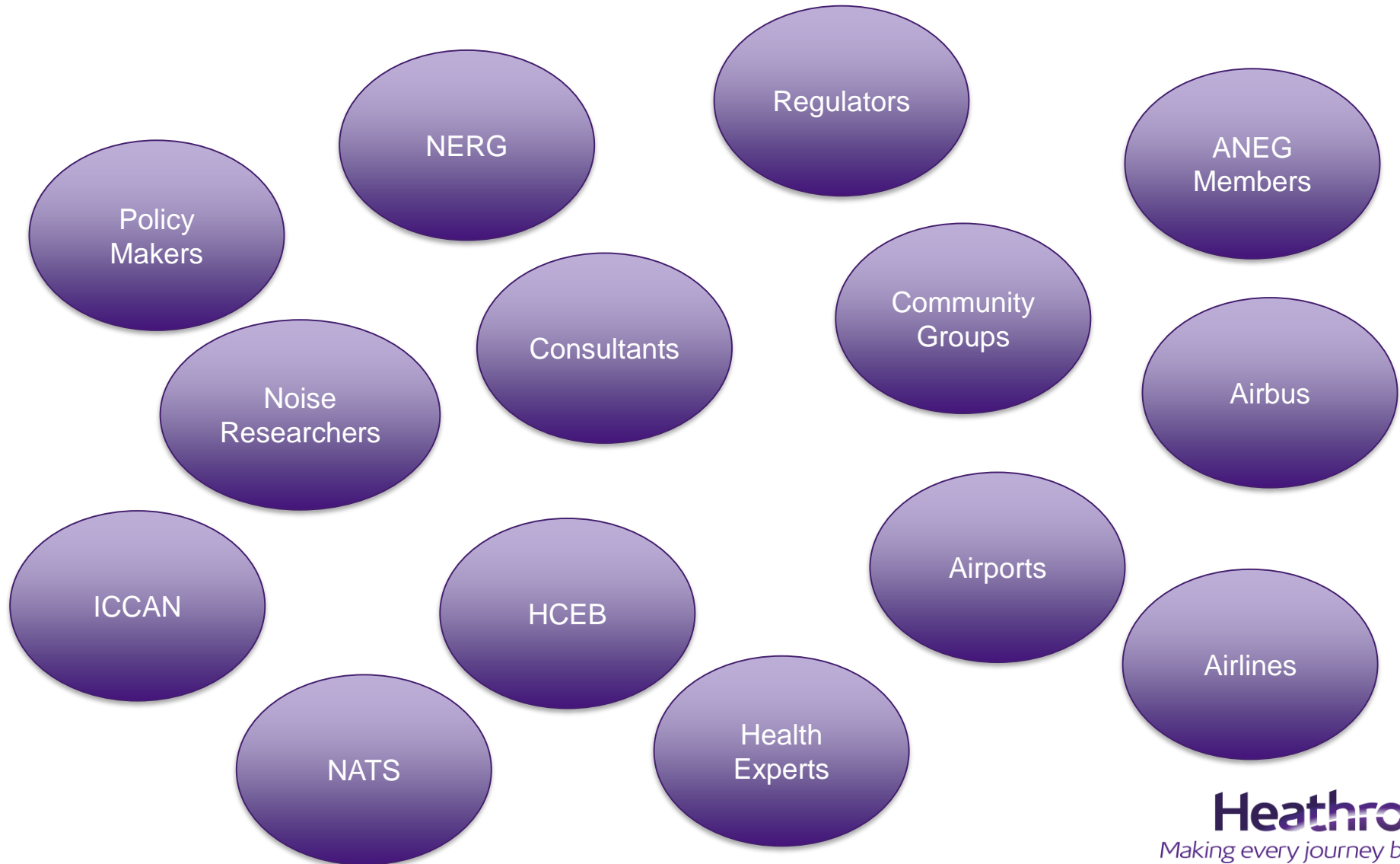


NOISE & ANNOYANCE WORKSHOP CONTENT AND FORMAT OVERVIEW

- Day was split into two sessions
- Session 1 – independently facilitated presentations from 4 speakers covering the WHO guidelines and SONA study.
 - Rainer Guski – covered WHO guidelines.
 - Darren Rhodes – covered the SONA study.
 - Charlotte Clark – set out how we plan to undertake our noise assessment with reference to both WHO and SONA.
 - Dave Gilbert – covered a community perspective on the WHO guidelines and SONA study highlighting concerns in relation to aviation policy.
- Session 2 – Internationally recognised expert panel “Question Time” independently chaired by ICCAN covering a range of noise and annoyance related questions.

Feedback

 - Format – initial feedback at the event and shortly after was very positive around the structure of the day, the content of the presentation's and the expert panel discussions.
