

General use of CP12A / CP12

CP12A remains a restricted control post with a list of approved users for entry into Other Airside Areas (OAA) and drivers will need to display a 'restricted access' permit which will be checked. To enter the CPSRA drivers must use the taxiway holding point and lane availability traffic light system to enter lane 2 of CP12 for search.

The road network has recently changed to incorporate the 703 / 704 back of stand road and drivers should familiarise themselves with the new layout as published in OSI 96.

A new pedestrian crossing is being installed between stands 702 / 703.

CP12A entry from landside

 Vehicle must display 'restricted access' permit or entry will not be permitted



Mike taxiway holding point

- All traffic going from OAA to Airside must use holding point
- 2. Do not cross taxiway if traffic lights are red
- 3. Normal uncontrolled crossings rules apply.



Hatched area – wingtip clearance

1. Do not wait on yellow hatched area.



Mike taxiway crossing

- I. Normal uncontrolled crossing rules apply
- 2. Green traffic lights only indicate the lane is available for search.



703/704 Back of Stand Road

 Users ensure they are familiar with the process stated in OSI 96 before using the back of stand road.



Holding point traffic lights

- Traffic lights are controlled by ICTS who also manage traffic from the BA holding point
- Green traffic lights only indicate the lane is available for search
- 3. Only one vehicle at a time may cross do not travel in convoy.



CP12 exit into AOF yard

- 1. Turn right onto road network
- Traffic will be joining from the left from CP12L1.



Route through AOF yard

1. Maintain speed limit of 10mph.



Exit AOF onto uncontrolled crossing

1. Normal uncontrolled crossing rules apply.
