

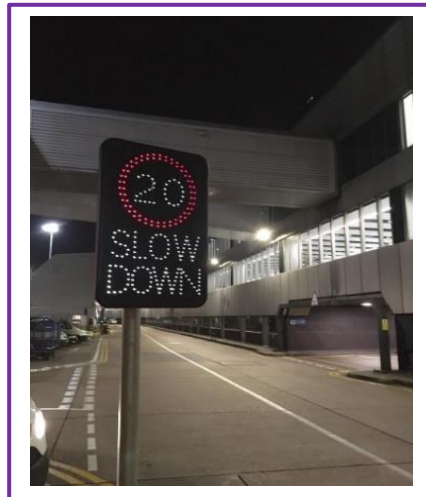
## Safety Alert

### Airside Road Network – Speed Limits

#### Introduction

Following the introduction of a speed monitoring trial which commenced on the 14<sup>th</sup> March 2020 using Speed Indicator Devices (SIDs), the data downloaded to date shows that on average, 17% of all vehicles are exceeding the published speed limits. Whilst we appreciate that airfield activity has significantly reduced recently, it's vital that safety standards are continuously maintained including the adherence to speed limits.

The purpose of this safety alert is to remind drivers of the importance of adhering to the published speed limits at all times. Speeding violations will be followed up by the Airside Standards Team in accordance with OSI\_087 – Management of Airside Infractions, with the potential for drivers to be issued between 3 and 12 penalty points.

**All companies should regularly review their telematics data in a proactive manner and challenge poor driving behaviour where appropriate.**
